THE CURRENT SITUATION

WHY IS THERE A NEED

- Stocks at Chesham for the Chiltern area are quite low at the moment.
- All Foodbanks are expecting further increases in demand as the impact of the current economic climate begins.
- The general increase in inflation, the huge increase in energy prices and the increase in national insurance contributions in April will put more strain on families whose personal finances are already precarious.
- Although some help from the government has been signalled, we anticipate that the charity sector, including Foodbanks, will be helping to fill the gap.

EFFECT ON WENDOVER

- The total weight of food distributed in 2021/22 from Wendover, was just under 3,000 Kg.
- This is greater than the weight of the food donated from the main donation sources in Wendover (Budgens, the churches and the Youth Centre collection), which has been around 1,600 Kg so far this year.
- We have become a net "importer" compared to previous having more food than we gave out.
- So this highlights the importance of this week to boost the stock levels.

INCREASE IN DEMAND

The table below shows the steep increase in demand for the Foodbank in the Wendover area. This is likely to continue to increase so please donate what you can and spread the word to friends and family
